Location

Engineering Building, Room 307 (ENGR 307), Utah State University, Logan, UT (online <u>campus map</u> or the <u>red circle</u> on the <u>pdf version of the map</u>).

Participant Drop Off

Drop off participants at the waiting area just east of the ENGR building. You can access this area directly from Highway 89 (400 North). See the **blue circle** on pdf version of the campus map.

Parking

Park in the public visitor parking on either the Aggie Parking Terrace (AGPT; on 700 East) or the Big Blue Parking Terrace (on 700 N; see **purple circles** on <u>pdf version of the campus map</u>). From either location, it's about a 10 minute walk to the ENGR building. We will give you tokens during the day to pay for parking when you leave.
